**Biological Anthropology**: 42 credits of coursework with 21 beyond the MA for students with an external MA degree and 12 credits beyond the MA with a UCB anthropology MA, 30 credits of dissertation hours, Ph.D. qualifying exam, Ph.D. prospectus, dissertation and dissertation defense

**Cultural Anthropology**: 42 credits of coursework with 21 beyond the MA for students with an external MA degree and 12 credits beyond the MA with a UCB anthropology MA), 30 credits of dissertation hours, ANTH 7840 research paper (for students entering without an MA in anthropology), PhD qualifying exam, Ph.D. prospectus, dissertation and dissertation defense

## **Terminal Master's Degree:**

Archaeology: 30 credits of coursework including an independent research paper (ANTH 7840)

Cultural Anthropology: 30 credits of coursework including an independent research paper (ANTH 7840)
