

## **Interim Document—Projected Graduate Curriculum in Anthropology for 2018-19**

*This is a brief outline of degree programs that the Department of Anthropology will offer in Fall of 2018, pending final approval by CU Administration:*

### **Doctoral Degree in Anthropology:**

**Archaeology:** 42 credits of coursework with 21 beyond the MA for students with an external MA degree and 12 credits beyond the MA with a UCB anthropology MA, 30 credits of dissertation hours, ANTH 7840 research paper (for students entering without an MA in anthropology), Ph.D. qualifying examination, Ph.D. prospectus, dissertation and dissertation defense

**Biological Anthropology:** 42 credits of coursework with 21 beyond the MA for students with an external MA degree and 12 credits beyond the MA with a UCB anthropology MA, 30 credits of dissertation hours, Ph.D. qualifying exam, Ph.D. prospectus, dissertation and dissertation defense

**Cultural Anthropology:** 42 credits of coursework with 21 beyond the MA for students with an external MA degree and 12 credits beyond the MA with a UCB anthropology MA), 30 credits of dissertation hours, ANTH 7840 research paper (for students entering without an MA in anthropology), PhD qualifying exam, Ph.D. prospectus, dissertation and dissertation defense

### **Terminal Master's Degree:**

**Archaeology:** 30 credits of coursework including an independent research paper (ANTH 7840)

**Cultural Anthropology:** 30 credits of coursework including an independent research paper (ANTH 7840)
