Biological Anthropology: 42 credits of coursework with 21 beyond the MA for students with an external MA degree and 12 credits beyond the MA with a UCB anthropology MA, 30 credits of dissertation hours, Ph.D. qualifying exam, Ph.D. prospectus, dissertation and dissertation defense

Cultural Anthropology: 42 credits of coursework with 21 beyond the MA for students with an external MA degree and 12 credits beyond the MA with a UCB anthropology MA), 30 credits of dissertation hours, ANTH 7840 research paper (for students entering without an MA in anthropology), PhD qualifying exam, Ph.D. prospectus, dissertation and dissertation defense

Terminal Master's Degree:

Archaeology: 30 credits of coursework including an independent research paper (ANTH 7840)

Cultural Anthropology: 30 credits of coursework including an independent research paper (ANTH 7840)
