2018- Present Lead Teaching Assistant

As Lead TA of my department I am serve as liaison between the Graduate Teacher Program (GTP) and the Art and Art History department. My main task is to assist with teacher training and professional development in my department. As GTP liaison, I forward GTP information to the department, encourage graduate students to continue to pursue their professional development throughout their graduate programs, assist other graduate students with the completion of requirements for the Graduate Teacher Program's certificates, and work on my interdisciplinary team.

I helped faculty conduct a pre-semester teaching orientation during the summer of 2018. I also provide microteaching sessions, observe or videotape and consult with teaching assistants about their actual classroom teaching, design mentoring activities to link incoming graduate students with students who have been in the program for a while, and have the liberty to develop a small original project related to classroom teaching for the department.

2017-Present Teaching Assistant

As teaching assistant, I teach three sections of the introduction to art history course called World Art. I am responsible for creating weekly lesson plans that help students review most salient points discussed in lecture. I am also responsible for grading, attendance, and facilitating

discussions based on weekly readings. I make sure to teach students how to think critically and develop essential writing skills needed for art history.

2016 Internship with the Department of Education at Laguna Art Museum

Compiled a manual for docents, researched individual artists and artworks in order to provide the docents with sufficient information. Created art history resource manual, researched certain art movements, artist bios, and art styles. Prepared materials for children's art projects.

I was head of the catalog committee, where I used InDesign to create catalog for the art show.
