

Transferology Instructions - How to get a list of pre-approved courses

Follow these instructions to get a list of courses that are already approved to transfer as equivalent to a specific CU Boulder course.

In the example below, a student wants to find a transfer course in California that will count for EBIO 1100.

1) Go to www.transferology.com and log in, or create an account if you don't already have one.

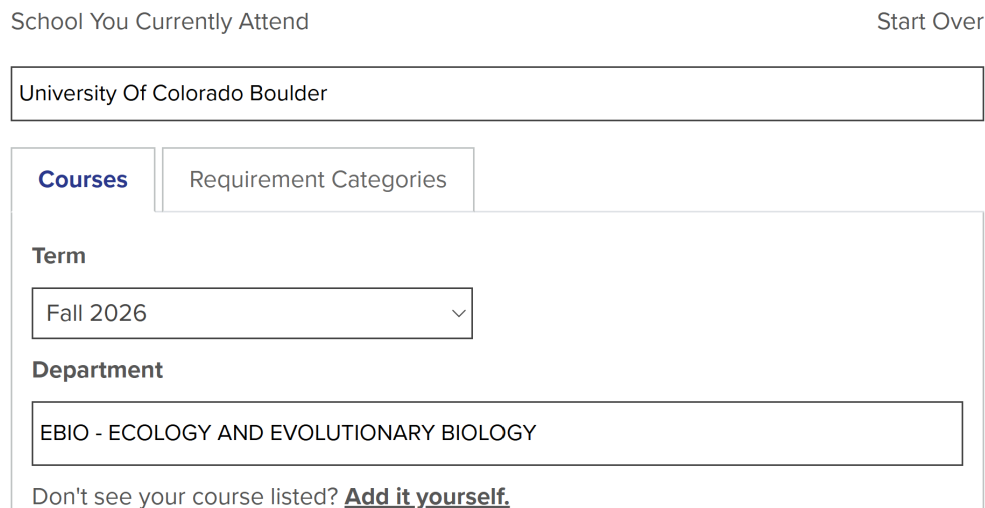
2) Click on "Find a Replacement Course."

6) If you want to search for multiple courses, repeat this process. The course(s) you've selected will show in the "My Courses" section on the right-hand side of the screen. When you're done adding courses, click "Search for Matches."

9) If you choose a course from the approved list, no additional approval is required. **Do not use the A&S Transfer Credit Review Request Form.** If you're looking for a specific course or school that isn't listed, follow the instructions in our other guide, "Transferology Instructions – How to see if a course is pre-approved."

Important! Even if a course is approved to transfer and to count toward your degree, you should be aware of the following:

- You must get a C- or higher for CU Boulder to accept the course for transfer. Your department may require a C or higher for the course to count toward your degree.
- You are responsible for making up any difference in semester credit hours between the CU Boulder course and the transfer course. Be especially cautious when taking a class on a quarter system, as these will be converted to semester hours when the class is transferred.
