- 1. General Updates:
  - a. EOY nominations: All nomination packets have been received and decisions on this will be discussed and made during the next month's meeting.

  - b. Officer Elections: The current Chair and Co-Chair will be cycling out of the committee at the end of this year so all positions will need to be filled.
- 2. Subcommittee Updates:
  - a. Processes: They are working to make additional amendments to the bylaws.

  - b. Communications/Outreach: They will be working with the support subcommittee when it comes to onboarding new staff members.
  - c. Salary: They met with college administration discussing the college's work in updating staff positions and classifications, and increasing transparency.
