The differentiated workload will reduce the formal teaching responsibilities of the Associate/Full Teaching Professor to one course of no less than 3-credit hours for that semester. The purpose of this workload adjustment is to allow the Associate/Full Teaching Professor time to update his or her pedagogy or instructional skills, or to develop new curriculum or instructional technology activities into courses. The faculty member on differentiated workload is expected to remain on campus and serve the campus full-time as defined by the workload agreement. Application for a differentiated workload assignment is made to the unit chair or director and approved in writing by the dean.*
