 - a. Staff Salaries subcommittee presented plan to continue to follow up with Kym Calvo in HR and the College of Arts and Sciences around A&S staff salary equity, particularly in light of the Equal Pay Act and budget impacts due to Covid-19.
- 3. A&S support plan presentation and discussion
 - a. A&S Support subcommittee presented plan for SAC to work with the College of Arts & Sciences around key A&S staff needs, particularly around staff recruitment, onboarding, training, professional development, engagement, networking and community building, mentorship, and retention.
