Resolution to Postpone Deployment of ChatGPT Edu

BFA-2026-03-05-1-R

Whereas, serious questions have been raised about privacy and indemnification clauses in the contract;

Whereas, pedagogical decisions involving this product require education about inherent race, language and cultural biases in LLMs, and such training units have not yet been created;

Whereas, there is not yet a policy in place on the CU Boulder campus or in the CU System to guide students, staff, or faculty in terms of ethical use of AI;

Be it resolved that, the University of Colorado Boulder Faculty Assembly calls on Chancellor Schwartz to ~~to postpone the deployment of ChatGPT Edu on the Boulder campus until after Maymester, 2026~~ subject ChatGPT Edu to the same conditions and data classification policies that currently apply to Microsoft Copilot, and to restrict faculty from sharing student work on ChatGPT Edu until such time as the serious issues in the CU OpenAI contract have been addressed, faculty have adopted an ethical use policy, and pedagogical training units have been approved by faculty.
