Meeting Minutes Thursday, March 7, 2024

The Boulder Faculty Assembly held a regular meeting which also served as the annual meeting of the Boulder Faculty Senate on Thursday March 7, 2024, via Zoom. BFA Vice Chair Alastair Norcross presided over the meeting. - I. <u>Buff Undergraduate Success (BUS) Update</u>

Project members Eggert and Thomas updated faculty regarding the revised charge for the group which includes a focus on: "cross-functional and cross-campus collaboration that results in policy and process improvement for all undergraduate students and particularly underrepresented students from historically marginalized groups." The project includes new members and is also working in concert with the priority projects as directed by the Chancellor for Academic Affairs and Strategic Resource Services. <u>BUS presentation slides</u>.

The Office of Information Technology (OIT) introduced a new IT decision framework model that campus will utilize to make decision-making more effect, more transparent, and to align with overall institution academic and research goals. Faculty will be represented in this model by the chair of the <u>BFA Academic Technologies & Services committee (ATSC)</u> who will have a seat on the Student & Academic Technology committee. <u>IT Decision Framework Model Slides</u>.

III. <u>APS 5060 Faculty Appointments</u> – Alastair Norcross, BFA V. Chair/ CU FC Chair Changes to this administrative policy statement went into effect on July 1, 2023. While campuses may choose to use either Instructor or Teaching Professor titles, Boulder will use Teaching Professor. That adjustment still needs to be made at System in CU's HCM software which is expected to happen sometime this summer.

- <u>CU Faculty Senate Constitution</u>
 - Although the appendix of APS5060 outlines faculty titles, the Faculty Senate Constitution defines membership in the CU Faculty Senate*.
 - Faculty Council has updated the Constitution to reflect APS5060 changes. A change to the constitution requires 2/3 majority approval by all University of Colorado faculty senate members.
 - Faculty who are eligible to vote will receive the ballot before April 1.
 - Please ensure your colleagues are aware of this process and encourage them to vote.



- CU Boulder Lecturers
 - APS 5060 defines Lecturers as temporary employees with less than a 50% appointment and are hired to teach one course. However, most lecturers on this campus are hired to teach more than one course and have greater than 50% appointments so System has asked Boulder to resolve this issue. Provost Moore formed a task force to work on solutions and guidelines for this issue. Members include Katherine Eggert, Robin Fergus, Shelly Miller, and Ann Schmiesing. Miller asked reps to contact her at bfa@colorado.edu if they (or a colleague) have ideas/experience in this kind of problem-solving.
