- I. <u>Address to Assembly</u> Justin Schwartz, Chancellor
 - The BFA welcomed incoming Chancellor Schwartz to his inaugural assembly meeting. He reviewed various items of priority for his first year on campus including sustainability and DEI, in particular around student success and faculty search processes. Chancellor Schwartz also asked members to nominate themselves or colleagues to be part of the upcoming <u>Provost search process</u>.
- II. <u>AY24-25 BFA Priorities & Actions</u> Shelly Miller, BFA Chair

Miller reviewed the results of the recent survey of representatives on the top general topics and actionable items that faculty feel the BFA should be working on. The results were based on responses from 74% of BFA representatives. The items most commonly noted that will be the actionable items for the BFA this year are listed below.

- Faculty pay equity
 - Will be worked on in the following BFA committees: FAC, TFAC, and Diversity
- Regenerative Artificial Intelligence (AI)
 - BFA/CTL AI Working Group dates/times/info coming soon
- Climate crisis areas will be worked on in BFA CORC and CSEC committees
- *Campus budget* a BPC reimagined group is meeting to redesign the BFA Budget & Planning committee.
- III. <u>AI Steering Team</u> Marin Stanek, Chief Information Officer
 - Beginning last spring, Stanek put together a campus AI steering committee designed to review AI efforts on campus in three domains 1. Teaching & Learning 2. Research and 3. Campus operations. The goal is to coordinate for knowledge sharing, best practices, and around use of AI in public domain utilizing university and student data. OIT has launched a new website on <u>Artificial Intelligence at CU Boulder</u>.
