

BFA Bylaws Committee Notice of Motion **Proposed Changes to the BFA Bylaws Article III Officer titles and duties** BFA-M-5.1-102124

Whereas the current BFA Officers positions as defined in Bylaws Article III do not adequately ensure continuity and the passing of institutional knowledge in BFA leadership;

Whereas Officer roles among our AAU peer institutions are organized so as to provide for continuity in transfer of leadership;

Whereas the CU Faculty Council is in the process of changing its organization of officer structure;

Therefore, to facilitate continuity in the transfer of leadership in the officers' roles in the BFA and to create alignment with the officer structure in Faculty Council and among our peer institutions; the BFA Bylaws Committee suggests the following changes to the BFA Bylaws Article III:

That Article III Section 1 be changed from

The Officers of the Assembly shall be the Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary. The Officers are initially elected to a term of two years.

To:

The Officers of the Assembly shall be the Chair, Chair-Elect, and Secretary. Nominees for Chair-Elect must have served at least four of the previous five years as a member of the BFA contiguous with the time of their nomination;

That Article III Section 4 be changed from

If the elected Chair is unable to complete his/her term, the Vice Chair automatically succeeds him/her for the remainder of the term. If the Vice Chair is unable to serve in the capacity of Chair, the Secretary shall hold elections to elect a new Chair within 21 days.

To:

If the elected Chair is unable to complete his/her term, the Chair-Elect automatically succeeds him/her for the remainder of the term. If the Chair-Elect is unable to serve in the capacity of Chair, the Secretary shall hold elections to elect a new Chair within 21 days'

And that Article III Section 6 describing the duties of the BFA Officers be moved from the Bylaws to the Standing Rules.
