## *Past Charges for the BFA Budget Committees*

### **2000-2006 BFA Budget Committee**

Original committee charge not available. However, originally this committee had a subcommittee called Faculty Compensation & Benefits committee which was absorbed by the Budget committee around 2006.

### **2007-2020 BFA Budget & Planning Committee (BPC or BAPC)**

The Budget and Planning Committee shall participate actively with the appropriate administrative officers in all substantive steps in and aspects of the development, implementation, and modification of the campus budget and the budget of the Academic Affairs division. These include participating in the activities of the Campus Budget Committee and the Academic Affairs Budget Advisory Committee. The Committee shall review Assembly notices of motion and resolutions that may have budgetary impact prior to the final vote on such notices of motion and resolutions. The Committee may initiate special budgetary studies and analyses relating to improving the efficiency and effectiveness of the University of Colorado at Boulder. One or more members shall also serve on the Faculty Council Budget Committee.

### **2021-2024 BFA Budget & Planning Committee**

The **Budget and Planning Committee (BPC)** shall work with the Chief Financial Officer, the Executive Vice Provost for Academic Resource Management, and other administrative officers and staff on the development, implementation, and modification of the campus budget and the budget of the Academic Affairs division. These include participating collaboratively in activities of Budget and Fiscal Planning and the Academic Affairs Budget Advisory Committee. BPC's work will include fiscal planning, transparency, and broader communication of the university budget to the campus community. The Committee shall review Assembly notices of motion and resolutions that may have a budgetary impact before the final vote on such notices of motion and resolutions. The Committee may initiate special budgetary studies and analyses relating to improving the efficiency and effectiveness of the University of Colorado at Boulder. One or more members shall also serve on the Faculty Council Budget Committee. The BPC will report on their work to the BFA Executive Committee and the BFA General Assembly (New as of April 29, 2021)
