The eleven members of the Boulder Faculty Assembly Diversity Committee met seven times in AY 2018-19 (three times in Fall and four times in Spring), supplemented by extensive email discussions.

In Fall 2018 the committee wrote and passed two resolutions: The Boulder Faculty Assembly approved a statement of support BFA-R-1-102218 in November 2018 for CU Boulder's transgender and gender non-conforming students, faculty, and staff in light of recent news headlines.

Building on last spring's resolution regarding the FCQ's, *BEST PRACTICES—MOVING BEYOND THE FCQ BFA-R-2-102918* was passed unanimously by the General Assembly in December 2018.

Also in Fall 18, we liaised with Lindsay Roberts, EMAC, system level diversity committee, who gave us a Civics draft update.

In Fall 2018, we invited guest speaker Director of International Academic Student Success, Roberto Arruda to discuss interfacing with international students, and anti-racist pedagogies. He returned to visit in Spring 2019 to introduce a new tutoring program for all non-native speakers of English.

During Spring 19, we reviewed and discussed the **faculty data** collected in prior years. We presented the data to Excom and would like to present to the general assembly. We are still awaiting those efforts.

In Spring 2019 the committee wrote a resolution in support of Upward Bound recognizing the traditional territories upon which CU Boulder sits:

We also conducted a graphic design contest, in order to recognize the efforts of faculty, staff, and students doing diversity work:
