

BFA Instructor-Track Faculty Affairs Committee Notice of Motion BFA Endorsement of the A&S Task Force on Instructor-Rank Faculty Report BFA-R-1-03.07.19

WHEREAS the Arts and Sciences Task Force on Instructor-Rank Faculty has submitted its findings and recommendation in a report to Interim Arts and Sciences Dean James White and Arts and Sciences Council Chair Stephen Mojzsis, co-sponsors of the Task Force, which has been accepted and published.

WHEREAS this report outlines five major areas negatively impacting Instructor-Rank Faculty and containing thirty-nine recommendations.

WHEREAS this report may have broad relevance to the CU Boulder campus with recommendations that, if enacted, could not only improve the lives of many instructors on campus but also have a positive impact on the campus's teaching mission and students' success.
