This is an important opportunity for you to participate in the shared faculty governance process at CU Boulder. The BFA Nominations and Elections Committee is requesting nominations for the following BFA committee seats.

Number of BFA standing committee seats up for election, by affiliation:

 - Administrative Services and Technology Committee: 1 A&S, 1 Non-A&S
 - Budget & Planning Committee: 1 A&S, 2 Non-A&S
 - Climate Science and Education Committee: 1 Non-A&S
 - Diversity Committee: 1 A&S
 - Faculty Affairs Committee: 2 A&S, 2 Non-A&S
 - Grievance Advisory Committee: 5 A&S or Non-A&S Tenured Faculty
 - Intercollegiate Athletics Committee: 1 Non-A&S
 - Instructor-Track Faculty Affairs Committee: 1 Instructor & 1 T/TT (A&S or Non-A&S):
 - Student Affairs Committee: 1 A&S
 - Libraries Committee: 1 – Humanities, 3 - Natural Sciences, 1 - Social Sciences, 1-Business, 1- CMCI, 1-Education, and 2 A&S or Non-A&S.
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- [CUPD Oversight Board](#): 2 A&S or Non-A&S – This new board will include two CU Boulder faculty who will be voted on by the BFA during committee elections.
 - [Honor Code Advisory Board](#): 4 A&S or Non-A&S – Statement of Interest should be completed by **September 13, 2021**. See the webpage linked above for details. The BFA Executive Committee selects the board members annually.

Nomination email packets should include:

1. the nominee's affiliation (A&S or Non-A&S), home department/unit, and contact details;
2. the specific committee seat of interest;
3. the nominee's confirmation (separate e-mail is fine) that they are willing to serve;
4. name and department/unit of the faculty member making the nomination (self-nominations are most welcome!);
5. an e-mail header containing the phrase "BFA Election Nomination"

Please email your nomination packet(s) to bfa@colorado.edu by 11:59 p.m., **Tuesday, September 14, 2021**. Nominees will be notified by email when election results are available. The election results will also be posted on the BFA web page.
