A&S (ASSET) FEE \$1.32 PER CREDIT HOUR PER SESSION

Applies to all classes in the College of Arts and Sciences regardless of a student's major or program of study.

APPLICATION FEE

One-time nonrefundable application fee

- -New domestic undergraduate students \$50
- -New international undergraduate students \$70

NEW STUDENT FEE

One-time nonrefundable fee upon entering a degree program

- -New undergraduate students and transfers \$232
- -New international undergraduates and transfers \$500

¹ In summer, nonresident tuition is a flat rate between 14 and 18 credit hours. It continues to increase at the same increment for each hour over 18.

² Fee totals do not include the A&S Tech (ASSET) Fee and the New Student Fee.

³ The Transit Pass Fee is waived for Summer 2023. Services will not change. Students can continue using bus and transit services throughout the summer.
