The Board of Regents reserves the right to change tuition and fees at any time. Tuition is based on residency classification, number of credit hours and your area of study. Fractional credit hours are assessed a portion of tuition between the two closest credit hours. Dual degrees and double majors are charged the higher rate. These rates apply to Boulder Main Campus only. Classes taken on different campuses including CU Boulder Online and Continuing Education have separate tuition, fees and billing. College Opportunity Fund (\$116 per credit hour per semester)

The College Opportunity Fund (COF) is a stipend for eligible undergraduate Colorado residents paying in-state tuition. The stipend pays a portion of tuition on a per-credit-hour basis. The COF stipend amount is set annually by the General Assembly. Eligible students must apply for and authorize the COF stipend in order to pay the student share.

Online Billing

- Tuition and fees are billed each semester.
- Bills are issued online only.
- Students can access their student account information and the bill in Buff Portal once they are enrolled.
- Parents and family members do not automatically have access to view the student account and the bill, but students can authorize them as
 payers to view and pay the bill in CUBill&Pay.
- Students can sign up for payment plans in Buff Portal; authorized payers sign up in CUBill&Pay.

Get Your Refund Fast and Easy - Sign Up for Direct Deposit

- Direct deposit allows for quick, secure transfer of refunds from scholarships, financial aid, housing deposits, bill adjustments, etc., into your bank account.
- Set up direct deposit in Buff Portal. (Direct deposit for tuition and fee refunds is separate from direct deposit for payroll.)

An Important Note about Health Insurance

- All students are required to have health insurance while attending CU Boulder.
- Undergraduate students enrolled in 6 or more credit hours must complete the health insurance requirement process by the published deadline.
- Students must complete this requirement in their first semester and again every fall. Otherwise, the student will be automatically enrolled in the Anthem Gold Student Health Insurance Plan and it will be added to the bill.
- ² Fee totals do not include the New Student Fee and are provided for planning purposes only. Actual fees may vary.
- ³ The A&S Tech (ASSET) Fee \$1.32 per credit hour will be eliminated for all students starting in Fall 2025.
