2025-26 Student Fee Changes

The following changes to fees will be in effect starting in Fall 2025; student services will remain the same:

- The Athletic Fee will increase to \$90 per semester, the first change to this fee since 1994.
- The A&S Tech (ASSET) Fee \$1.32 per credit hour will be eliminated for all student starting in Fall 2025.
- The following fees will be converted to tuition starting in Fall 2025 and will no longer be assessed individually (student services will remain the same): Arts & Cultural Enrichment Fee, Career Services Fee, Mental Health Resource Fee, Student Computing Fee, Student Health Fee and the Transit Pass Fee.

College Opportunity Fund (\$116 per credit hour per semester)

The College Opportunity Fund (COF) is a stipend for eligible undergraduate Colorado residents paying in-state tuition. The stipend pays a portion of tuition on a per-credit-hour basis. The COF stipend amount is set annually by the General Assembly. Eligible students must apply for and authorize the COF stipend in order to pay the student share. This stipend does not need to be paid back

Online Billing

- Tuition and fees are billed each semester.
- Bills are issued online only.
- Students can access their student account information and the bill in Buff Portal once they are enrolled.
- Parents and family members do not automatically have access to view the student account and the bill, but students can authorize them as
 payers to view and pay the bill in CUBill&Pay.
- Students can sign up for payment plans in Buff Portal; authorized payers sign up in CUBill&Pay.

An Important Note about Health Insurance

- All students are required to have health insurance while attending CU Boulder.
- Undergraduate students enrolled in 6 or more credit hours must complete the health insurance requirement process by the published deadline.
- Students must complete this requirement in their first semester and again every fall. Otherwise, the student will be automatically enrolled in the Anthem Gold Student Health Insurance Plan and it will be added to the bill.
