These rates apply to Boulder Main Campus only. Classes taken on different campuses including CU Boulder Online and Continuing Education have separate tuition, fees and billing. 2025–26 Mandatory Student Fee Changes

The following changes to fees will be in effect starting in Fall 2025; student services will remain the same:

- The A&S Tech (ASSET) Fee \$1.32 per credit hour will be eliminated for all student starting in Fall 2025.
- The following fees will be converted to tuition starting in Fall 2025 and will no longer be assessed individually (student services will remain the same): Arts & Cultural Enrichment Fee, Career Services Fee,³ Mental Health Resource Fee, Student Computing Fee, Student Health Fee and the Transit Pass Fee.

Fee Waivers for Graduate Assistants: Eligible graduate assistants will receive a waiver for mandatory fees listed on this page except for the New Student Fee. Student Health Insurance
