2025-26 Mandatory Student Fee Changes

The following changes to fees will be in effect starting in Fall 2025; student services will remain the same:

- The A&S Tech (ASSET) Fee \$1.32 per credit hour will be eliminated for all student starting in Fall 2025.
- The following fees will be converted to tuition starting in Fall 2025 and will no longer be assessed individually (student services will remain the same): Arts & Cultural Enrichment Fee, Career Services Fee, Mental Health Resource Fee, Student Computing Fee, Student Health Fee and the Transit Pass Fee.

All students are required to have health insurance while attending CU Boulder. Students must meet this requirement their first semester at CU Boulder and at the beginning of each academic year.
