Rates published by the Bursar's Office are approved by the Board of Regents annually in accordance with the level of cash fund appropriations set for the university by the Colorado General Assembly. The Board of Regents reserves the right to change tuition and fees at any time. Tuition is based on residency classification, number of credit hours and your college, school or program. Fractional credit hours are assessed a portion of tuition between the two closest credit hours. Dual degrees and double majors are charged the higher rate. These rates apply to Boulder Main Campus only. Classes taken on different campuses including CU Boulder Online and Continuing Education have separate tuition, fees and billing. Costs listed on this sheet are billed directly by CU Boulder but may not include everything. ### Online Billing

- Tuition and fees are billed each semester.
- Bills are issued online only.
- Students can access their student account information and the bill in Buff Portal once they are enrolled.
- Parents and family members can view and pay the bill online when students authorize them as payers in CUBill&Pay.
- Students can sign up for payment plans in Buff Portal; authorized payers sign up in CUBill&Pay.

<sup>1</sup> The first credit hour is priced at a higher rate than subsequent credits because the tuition rate is not linear; it does not increase proportionally with the number of credits taken.

<sup>2</sup> Tuition is a flat rate for 9 credit hours or more.

### Masters Student Status

A maximum of 3 hours should be taken per semester, as this registration placeholder cannot be used toward a student's degree.)
