Tuition Guarantee Groups

- Group R: Students first enrolled in Summer 2022, Fall 2022 or Spring 2023 (Students first enrolled in Summer 2022 pay Group Q rates in Summer 2022 and then move to Group R rates starting in Fall 2022.)
- Group Q: Students first enrolled in Summer 2021, Fall 2021 or Spring 2022
- Group P: Students first enrolled in Summer 2020, Fall 2020 or Spring 2021
- Group 0: Students first enrolled in Summer 2019, Fall 2019 or Spring 2020

Online Billing

- Tuition and fees are billed each semester.
- Bills are issued online only.
- Students can access their student account information and the bill in Buff Portal once they are enrolled.
- Parents and family members do not automatically have access to view the student account and the bill, but students can authorize them as payers to view and pay the bill in CUBill&Pay.

College Opportunity Fund (\$104 per credit hour per semester)

- The College Opportunity Fund (COF) is a stipend for eligible undergraduates paying in-state tuition.
- The stipend pays a portion of total tuition for undergraduate students who attend a Colorado public institution or a participating private institution. The stipend is paid to the institution on a per-credit-hour basis, and the credit-hour amount is set annually by the General Assembly.
- Students must complete the COF application on the official state College Opportunity Fund website and authorize use of funds to receive COF.
 Students who do not complete both of these steps will be responsible for paying the total in-state tuition.

Make Payments Easier with Payment Plans

- CU Boulder offers interest-free payment plans each semester and in the summer.
- Allows you to pay the university bill in smaller, more manageable monthly installments.
- Students sign up for payment plans in Buff Portal and authorized payers sign up in CUBill&Pay.

Get Your Refund FAST! Sign Up for Direct Deposit

- Direct deposit allows for quick, secure transfer of refunds from scholarships, financial aid, confirmation deposits, housing deposits, bill adjustments, etc., into your bank account.
- Set up direct deposit in Buff Portal. (Direct deposit for tuition and fee refunds is separate from direct deposit for payroll.)

An Important Note about Health Insurance

- All students are required to have health insurance while attending CU Boulder.
- Undergraduate students enrolled in 6 or more credit hours must complete the health insurance requirement process by the published deadline.
- Students must complete this requirement in their first semester and again every fall. Otherwise, the student will be automatically enrolled in the CU Gold Student Health Insurance Plan and it will be added to the bill.
