Fractional credit hours outside of flat rate tuition are assessed the average rate between the two closest credit hours. Dual degrees are charged the higher rate. These rates apply to Boulder Main Campus only. Classes taken on different campuses and Continuing Education have separate tuition, fees and billing. Rates and deadlines may be subject to change.

OTHER REQUIRED FEES

A&S (ASSET) FEE \$1.32 PER CREDIT HOUR PER SESSION

Applies to all classes in the College of Arts and Sciences regardless of a student's major or program of study.

APPLICATION FEE

One-time nonrefundable application fee
 -New domestic undergraduate students \$50
 -New international undergraduate students \$70

IMMIGRATION COMPLIANCE FEE

Applies to international students only \$40

NEW STUDENT FEE

One-time nonrefundable fee upon entering a degree program
 -New undergraduate students and transfers \$232
 -New international undergraduates and transfers \$500

¹ In summer, international tuition is a flat rate between 14 and 18 credit hours. It continues to increase at the same increment for each hour over 18.

² Fee totals do not include the A&S Tech (ASSET) Fee, the Immigration Compliance Fee and the New Student Fee.

³ The Transit Pass Fee is waived for Summer 2023. Services will not change. Students can continue using bus and transit services throughout the summer.
