The stipend pays a portion of total tuition for undergraduate students who attend a Colorado public institution or a participating private institution. The stipend is paid to the institution on a per-credit-hour basis, and the credit-hour amount is set annually by the General Assembly. Students must complete the COF application on the official state College Opportunity Fund website and authorize use of funds to receive COF. Students who do not complete both of these steps will be responsible for paying the total in-state tuition.</p> |                                 |

One-time nonrefundable application fee; this fee is not waived for graduate assistants.

##### NEW STUDENT FEE

One-time nonrefundable fee upon entering a degree program

-New undergraduate students and transfers \$232

-New international undergraduates and transfers \$500
