Rates published by the Bursar's Office are approved by the Board of Regents annually in accordance with the level of cash fund appropriations set for the university by the Colorado General Assembly. The Board of Regents reserves the right to change tuition and fees at any time. Tuition charged is based on residency classification, number of credit hours and your college, school or program. Fractional credit hours outside of flat rate tuition are assessed the average rate between the two closest credit hours. Dual degrees are charged the higher rate. These rates apply to Boulder Main Campus only. Classes taken on different campuses and Continuing Education have separate tuition, fees and billing. Rates and deadlines may be subject to change.

Cost of Attendance

Tuition and fees are just one part of the overall cost to attend CU Boulder. The full cost of attendance for an academic year could include expenses such as on-campus housing and food, books and supplies, and items that are not billed by the university, such as personal expenses, transportation and medical insurance. ² The student share of tuition is a flat rate between 12 and 18 credit hours. Total tuition continues to increase at the same increment for each hour over 18.

³ 12 credit hours per semester is considered full-time to receive financial aid. Graduating in four year requires enrollment in at least 15 credit hours per semester.

College Opportunity Fund (\$116 per credit hour per semester)

The College Opportunity Fund (COF) is a stipend for eligible undergraduate Colorado residents paying in-state tuition. The stipend pays a portion of tuition on a per-credit-hour basis. The COF stipend amount is set annually by the General Assembly. Eligible students must apply for and authorize the COF stipend in order to pay the student share.

Online Billing

- Tuition and fees are billed each semester.
- Bills are issued online only.
- Students can access their student account information and the bill in Buff Portal once they are enrolled.
- Parents and family members do not automatically have access to view the student account and the bill, but students can authorize them as payers to view and pay the bill in CUBill&Pay.
- Students can sign up for payment plans in Buff Portal; authorized payers sign up in CUBill&Pay.

Get Your Refund Fast and Easy - Sign Up for Direct Deposit

- Direct deposit allows for quick, secure transfer of refunds from scholarships, financial aid, confirmation deposits, housing deposits, bill adjustments, etc., into your bank account.
- Set up direct deposit in Buff Portal. (Direct deposit for tuition and fee refunds is separate from direct deposit for payroll.)

An Important Note about Health Insurance

- All students are required to have health insurance while attending CU Boulder.
- Undergraduate students enrolled in 6 or more credit hours must complete the health insurance requirement process by the published deadline.
- Students must complete this requirement in their first semester and again every fall. Otherwise, the student will be automatically enrolled in the Anthem Gold Student Health Insurance Plan and it will be added to the bill.
