Rates published by the Bursar's Office are approved by the Board of Regents annually in accordance with the level of cash fund appropriations set for the university by the Colorado General Assembly. The Board of Regents reserves the right to change tuition and fees at any time. Tuition charged is based on residency classification, number of credit hours and your college, school or program. Fractional credit hours outside of flat rate tuition are assessed the average rate between the two closest credit hours. Dual degrees are charged the higher rate. These rates apply to Boulder Main Campus only. Classes taken on different campuses and Continuing Education have separate tuition, fees and billing. Rates and deadlines may be subject to change.

Beginning in Summer 2024, students enrolled in 1-3 credit hours will pay tuition per credit hour instead of a flat rate. See CU Boulder Today - Change in tuition.

² The student share of tuition is a flat rate between 12 and 18 credit hours. Total tuition continues to increase at the same increment for each hour over 18.

³ 12 credit hours per semester is considered full-time to receive financial aid. Graduating in four year requires enrollment in at least 15 credit hours per semester.

BILLS

STUDENT HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN TENTATIVE RATES

Anthem Gold Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) \$2,240 BuffCare Supplement \$270

All students are required to have health insurance while attending CU Boulder. Undergraduate students enrolled in 6 or more credit hours must complete the health insurance requirement process by the published deadline. Students must complete this requirement in their first semester and again every fall. Otherwise, the student will be automatically enrolled in the Anthem Gold Student Health Insurance Plan and it will be added to the bill. colorado.edu/health/insurance

PAYMENT PLANS

CU Boulder offers interest-free payment plans to pay the tuition and fee bill month over the course of each semester and summer. Payment plans divide the university bill into smaller, more manageable monthly installments. Students sign up for payment plans in Buff Portal; authorized payers sign up in CUBill&Pay. colorado.edu/bursar/payments/payment-plans.

DIRECT DEPOSIT FOR TUITION & FEE REFUNDS
