Rates published by the Bursar's Office are approved by the Board of Regents annually in accordance with the level of cash fund appropriations set for the university by the Colorado General Assembly. The Board of Regents reserves the right to change tuition and fees at any time. Tuition charged is based on residency classification, number of credit hours and your college, school or program. Fractional credit hours outside of flat rate tuition are assessed the average rate between the two closest credit hours. Dual degrees and double majors are charged the higher rate. These rates apply to Boulder Main Campus only. Classes taken on different campuses and Continuing Education have separate tuition, fees and billing. Rates and deadlines may be subject to change.

Cost of Attendance

Tuition and fees are just one part of the overall cost to attend CU Boulder. The full cost of attendance for an academic year could include expenses such as on-campus housing and food, books and supplies, and items that are not billed by the university, such as personal expenses, transportation and medical insurance. Tuition Guarantee

The CU Boulder Tuition Guarantee applies to this program, the same tuition and fee rates for four calendar years.

Groups A-Q: first enrolled Spring 2022 or earlier

Group R: first enrolled Summer 2022, Fall 2022 or Spring 2023

Group S: first enrolled Summer 2023, Fall 2023 or Spring 2024

Group T: students first enrolled in Summer 2024, Fall 2024 or Spring 2025

Students first enrolled in Summer 2024 pay Group T rates in Summer 2024 and then move to Group U rates starting in Fall 2025.

College Opportunity Fund (\$1163 per credit hour per semester)

- The College Opportunity Fund (COF) is a stipend for eligible undergraduates paying in-state tuition.
- The stipend pays a portion of total tuition for undergraduate students who attend a Colorado public institution or a participating private institution. The stipend is paid to the institution on a per-credit-hour basis, and the credit-hour amount is set annually by the General Assembly.
- Students must complete the COF application on the official state College Opportunity Fund website and authorize use of funds to receive COF. Students who do not complete both of these steps will be responsible for paying the total in-state tuition.

Payment Plans

- CU Boulder offers interest-free payment plans to pay the tuition and fee bill month over the course of each semester and summer.
- Payment plans divide the university bill into smaller, more manageable monthly installments.
- Students sign up for payment plans in Buff Portal; authorized payers sign up in CUBill&Pay.

Get Your Refund Fast and Easy - Sign Up for Direct Deposit

- Direct deposit allows for quick, secure transfer of refunds from scholarships, financial aid, confirmation deposits, housing deposits, bill adjustments, etc., into your bank account.
- Set up direct deposit in Buff Portal. (Direct deposit for tuition and fee refunds is separate from direct deposit for payroll.)
