#### MASTER'S STUDENT STATUS

A - registered for coursework and/or master's thesis hours

B - registered for "candidate for degree", course #6940-6949 (Students who are required to be registered for thesis defense or master's final exam but have no courses or thesis hours left to take, and/or students who must remain full time. A maximum of 3 hours should be taken per semester, as this registration placeholder cannot be used toward a student's degree.)

#### DOCTORAL STUDENT STATUS

Pre-comprehensive exam

C - registered for coursework or coursework/dissertation hour combination

E - registered for dissertation hours only

Post-comprehensive exam

D - registered for 3 or 5+ dissertation hours as require by graduate school rules (status is assigned by the graduate school following admission to candidacy)

### ASSISTANTSHIPS

Research assistantships (RA), teaching assistantships (TA) and graduate part-time instructor (GPTI) appointments typically pay for a portion of or all of your tuition however you are still responsible for paying mandatory fees (see reverse side), course and program fees each semester. The amount of the waiver is based on your contract. If you have questions, check with your department.
