The stipend pays a portion of total tuition for undergraduate students who attend a Colorado public institution or a participating private institution. The stipend is paid to the institution on a per-credit-hour basis, and the credit-hour amount is set annually by the General Assembly. Students must complete the COF application on the official state College Opportunity Fund website and authorize use of funds to receive COF. Students who do not complete both of these steps will be responsible for paying the total in-state tuition.

Fractional credit hours outside of flat rate tuition are assessed the average rate between the two closest credit hours. Dual degrees and double majors are charged the higher rate. These rates apply to Boulder Main Campus only. Classes taken on different campuses and Boulder Continuing Education have separate tuition, fees and billing. A&S (ASSET) FEE \$1.32 PER CREDIT HOUR PER SESSION

Applies to all classes in the College of Arts and Sciences regardless of a student's major or program of study.

NEW STUDENT FEE

One-time nonrefundable fee upon entering a degree program

-New undergraduate students and transfers \$232

-New international undergraduates and transfers \$500

College Opportunity Fund (COF) - \$116 per credit hour per semester (colorado.edu/registrar/students/state-residency/admitted/cof)

CU Boulder Tuition Guarantee

Tuition for undergraduate nonresident and international students is guaranteed to be the same rate for four calendar years.

Groups A–Q: Students first enrolled in Summer 2021, Fall 2021 or Spring 2022

Group R: Students first enrolled in Summer 2022, Fall 2022 or Spring 2023

Group S: Students first enrolled in Summer 2023, Fall 2023 or Spring 2024

Group T: Students first enrolled in Summer 2024, Fall 2024 or Spring 2025

Students first enrolled in Summer 2025 pay Group T rates in Summer 2025 and then move to Group U rates (published in July) starting in Fall 2025.

¹ The student share of tuition is a flat rate between 12 and 18 credit hours. Total tuition continues to increase at the same increment for each hour over 18.

² Fee totals do not include the A&S Tech (ASSET) Fee and the New Student Fee.
