Rates published by the Bursar's Office are approved by the Board of Regents annually in accordance with the level of cash fund appropriations set for the university by the Colorado General Assembly. The Board of Regents reserves the right to change tuition and fees at any time. Summer nonresident tuition is charged based on residency classification, number of credit hours and your area of study. Fractional credit hours outside of flat rate tuition are assessed the average rate between the two closest credit hours. Dual degrees and double majors are charged the higher rate. These rates apply to Boulder Main Campus only. Classes taken on different campuses and Boulder Continuing Education have separate tuition, fees and billing. Costs listed on this sheet are billed directly by CU Boulder but may not include everything. See Understanding Your Cost of Attendance (colorado.edu/understand-your-cost-attendance). Rates and deadlines may be subject to change.

CU Boulder Tuition Guarantee

Tuition for undergraduate nonresident and international students is guaranteed to be the same rate for four calendar years.

Groups A–Q: Students first enrolled in Summer 2021, Fall 2021 or Spring 2022

Group R: Students first enrolled in Summer 2022, Fall 2022 or Spring 2023

Group S: Students first enrolled in Summer 2023, Fall 2023 or Spring 2024

Group T: Students first enrolled in Summer 2024, Fall 2024 or Spring 2025

Students first enrolled in Summer 2025 pay Group T rates in Summer 2025 and then move to Group U rates (published in July) starting in Fall 2025.

One-time nonrefundable fee upon entering a degree program
