ASSISTANTSHIPS

Research assistantships (RA), teaching assistantships (TA) and graduate part-time instructor (GPTI) appointments typically pay for a portion of or all of your tuition however you are still responsible for paying mandatory fees (see reverse side) and course and program fees each semester. The amount of the waiver is based on your contract. If you have questions, check with your department.

BILLING

Bills are online only. Students access billing information in MyCUInfo once they are enrolled. Parents and other family members need to get access from their students in order to view the bill. Students authorize payers in MyCUInfo. Authorized payers access billing information in CUBill&Pay.

PAYMENT PLANS

Eligible students and authorized payers can pay the university bill over the course of the semester. More information is available at <u>bursar.colorado.edu</u>.

The Board of Regents reserves the right to change tuition and fee rates at any time. Tuition charged is based on residency, degree and number of credit hours. Fractional credit hours outside of flat rate tuition are assessed the average rate between the two closest credit hours. Dual degrees are charged the higher rate. These rates apply to Boulder Main Campus only. Rates may be subject to change.
