COLLEGE OPPORTUNITY FUND \$85 per credit hour/semester

The College Opportunity Fund (COF), created by the Colorado legislature, provides a stipend to eligible undergraduates paying in-state tuition. The stipend pays a portion of total tuition for undergraduate students who attend a Colorado public institution or a participating private institution. The stipend is paid to the institution on a per-credit-hour basis, and the credit-hour amount is set annually by the General Assembly. Students must complete the COF application on the official state College Opportunity Fund website and authorize use of funds to receive COF. Students who do not complete both of these steps will be responsible for paying the total in-state tuition.

Rates published by the Bursar's Office are the official rates approved by the Board of Regents and reflect the most accurate and up-to-date tuition and fee information. The Board of Regents reserves the right to change rates at any time. Tuition charged is based on residency, degree and number of credit hours. Fractional credit hours outside of flat rate tuition are assessed the average rate between the two closest credit hours. Dual degrees are charged the higher rate. These rates apply to Boulder Main Campus only. Classes taken in Continuing Education incur separate tuition and fees. Rates and guarantee groups may be subject to change.

All students are required to have health insurance. Undergraduate students enrolled in 6 or more credit hours are automatically enrolled in the Student Gold Health Insurance Plan and the cost is added to the bill unless you actively change your selection in MyCUInfo every fall by published deadlines.

BILLS

Bills are online only. Students access billing information in MyCUInfo once they are enrolled. Parents and other family members need to get access from their students in order to view the bill. Students authorize payers in MyCUInfo. Authorized payers access billing information in CUBill&Pay.

PAYMENT PLANS (enrollment fee \$25)

Eligible students and authorized payers can pay the university bill over the course of the semester. Students sign up for payment plans in MyCUInfo. Authorized payers sign up in CUBill&Pay. More information at https://www.colorado.edu/bursar/payments/payment-plans.

DIRECT DEPOSIT FOR TUITION & FEE REFUNDS

Direct deposit allows for quick, secure deposit of refunds from confirmation deposits, housing deposits, scholarships, financial aid, overpayments, etc. into your bank account. Set up direct deposit in MyCUInfo. Direct deposit of tuition and fee refunds is unrelated to payroll direct deposit.
