All students are required to have health insurance. Undergraduate students enrolled in 6 or more credit hours are automatically enrolled in the Student Gold Health Insurance Plan and the cost is added to the bill unless you actively change your selection once a year in the fall by published deadlines in MyCUInfo.

### BILLING

Bills are online only. Students access billing information in MyCUInfo once they are enrolled. Parents and other family members need to get access from their students in order to view the bill. Students authorize payers in MyCUInfo. Authorized payers access billing information in CUBill&Pay.

### PAYMENT PLANS
