Rates published by the Bursar’s Office are approved by the Board of Regents annually in accordance with the level of cash fund appropriations set for the university by the Colorado General Assembly. Rates and deadlines may be subject to change. Tuition is based on degree and number of credit hours, and it is assessed on a linear credit hour basis (each credit hour is the same rate). Tuition continues to increase at the same increment for each hour over 15.
