## **MS Finance Program Plan**



The 9-month MS Finance provides extensive course work and an in-depth application of materials, preparing students for a range of job opportunities. In addition to the course work, enrichment seminars in topics ranging from teamwork and leadership to ethics and corporate social responsibility support the "whole student" experience by incorporating professional development into the academic experience.

The focused curriculum offers a firm grounding in general finance and helps to develop the specific skills necessary to pursue careers in a variety of financial fields.

The Finance degree offers two "tracks" to develop skills in specific disciplines:

- Investment Management track provides the skills necessary to pursue a career with an investment management firm and prepares students to take the CFA Level I exam.
- Corporate Finance/Consulting track prepares students for a career in management consulting, investment banking, private equity and venture capital.
