Faculty counts were pulled Spring of 2018. The UTD "Score" in column E comes from the UTD Website. UTD counts number of papers those in top journals. For each paper UTD divides up credit among the authors, each school the author, each school the author list as their affiliation will get .5 added to their UTD Score.
