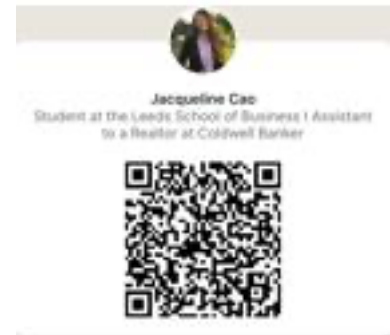


Jacqueline Cao

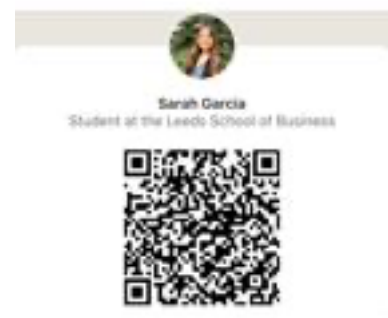

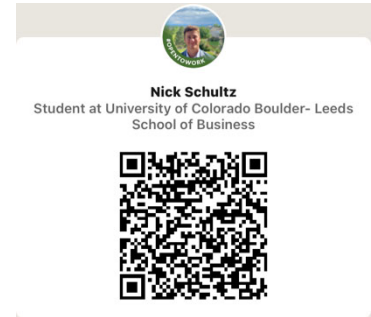
