Transferology Instructions - How to get a list of pre-approved courses

Follow these instructions to get a list of courses that are already approved to transfer as equivalent to a specific CU Boulder course.

In the example below, a student wants to find a transfer course in Texas that will count for CVEN 2121.


- 1) Go to www.transferology.com and log in, or create an account if you don't already have one.
- 2) Click on "Find a Replacement Course."



3) In the "School You Currently Attend" field, start typing "University of Colorado Boulder" and select it from the drop-down list that appears.



4) In the "Department" field, start typing the department code of the CU Boulder course, and select it from the drop-down list that appears.



5) A list of courses will appear for the school/department you have selected. Click the + symbol next to the course you want.



6) If you want to search for multiple courses, repeat this process. The course(s) you've selected will show in the "My Courses" section on the right-hand side of the screen. When you're done adding courses, click "Search for Matches."



7) A list of schools with equivalent courses will appear. You can filter the results by location, if desired. Please note that there is no way to filter for courses offered online, or courses offered in summer – you will need to research approved courses on your own to find this information.


To see the specific course that's approved at a school, click the blue "Match" box.

9) If you choose a course from the approved list, no additional approval is required. Do not use the CEAS Transfer Credit Review Form. If you're looking for a specific course or school that isn't listed, follow the instructions in our other guide, "Transferology Instructions – How to see if a course is pre-approved."

Important! Even if a course is approved to transfer <u>and</u> to count toward your degree, you should be aware of the following:

- You must get a C- or higher for CU Boulder to accept the course for transfer. Your department may require a C or higher for the course to count toward your degree.
- You are responsible for making up any difference in <u>semester</u> credit hours between the CU Boulder course and the transfer course. Be especially cautious when taking a class on a quarter system, as these will be converted to semester hours when the class is transferred.
- You must petition to waive the In-Residence Credit Requirement if you will be within 45 credits of graduation when you take the transfer course.
