






# **VISIBILITY STUDY** :

We noticed that a large reason why people will not pass through and stay in St. Stephen's Plaza is because it prevents people from being able to see through to the other side. If people cannot see a clear secondary exit (different from the one they entered through), they will tend not to go that way. This is something that needs to change with future design if this space is to be successful.






#### SUN/SHADE ANALYSIS:

Through extensive analysis of the sun's path over St. Stephen's plaza we have come to a few conclusions. With a tall south wall the winter months are cold and dark. The higher sun in the summer will cause the west and east sides of the site can reach extremely high temperatures with the sun hitting the concrete paving. To accommodate the temperature changes we have designed a shade structure, fire pit, and warmer materials.



## **STAGE PERSPECTIVES:**





For larger events we suggest utilizing a large rental stage that can be moved to the back alley area. Both east and west sides can be used for meeting areas or a stage area.

#### SEATING & TABLES:



The psychological importance of movable furniture on a public space elevates a design to a different level. By having smaller and lighter furniture our breezeway will really open up. "Unlike bolted down chairs or other forms of hostile or unfriendly architecture, free-floating chairs provide park goers with an implicit sense of trust, and with that, a freedom to improvise."The chair itself is not magical but what it can achieve in the right circumstance is," Winn said. He added: "It shows a lot of respect to the user. People come into the space and instinctively understand the basic code of behavior." Movable seating does run the risk of getting stolen but they are a fraction of the price point of traditional park tables and benches. With the freedom

for a flexible design in St. Stephen's Plaza the movable seating will allow many more functions and programming. .








#### ART PEDESTAL & THE KITCHEN WALL DETAILS:



Above is a graphic representation of our in-ground art pedestals. Above the structure we will have plants to disguise the structure if no art is being attached to it. This design would be smaller and more hidden than the original design.

The Kitchen Wall will be composed of 3 different installations. On the East and west side there is prime real estate for rotating murals. In the middle segment we have designed a detached lattice structure for hardy plants to grow year around.



# LIGHTING:



To separate the parking spots and the plaza we have found a beautiful light pole design. This would be able to be moved and redistributed around St. Stephen's Plaza if there was an event taking place using the back alley.

The iGuzzini Typha will achieve this look by using a spike base that is flushed with the ground. By having the bases around the site these will be movable and adjustable depending on the programming happening in the alley. Artists could also be brought in to design something similar for the site.



# MAINTENANCE PLAN & COST ESTIMATES:

**Plantings:** The planting plan of PASSAGE fits the context of a Colorado gathering space way better than the previous planting design. The chosen plants are well suited to the dry weather and long winters that Colorado's climate brings. Planting is intended to provide vertical interest through vines, large shrubs, perennials, and ornamental grasses. PASSAGE also includes many plants such as broad-leaf evergreens and ornamental grasses that provide interest throughout the winter. Seating: No maintenance required except for the removal of movable furniture for events.

**Decking:** No maintenance except seasonal cleaning for weather resistant decking. Shade Structure: Removal of shade structure in winter months and replaced if it gets faded over time.

Light Poles: No maintenance required except changing of LED lights. Built in bench: Snow removal.

Fire feature: Regular Maintenance is required to ensure safety while the feature is in use. Regular cleaning of flammable debris is required when necessary circumstances arise. Major maintenance is minimal due to the minimalistic design and functionality of the feature.

Water feature: There is no real maintenance regarding the upkeep of this feature, however, caution has to be taken to ensure that the water pumps continue to function regularly and as efficiently as possible. This feature is also self circulating and free standing, meaning that it functions independently from the surrounding features of the site.
