



Hurry- Hurry- Learn if you qualify to APPLY

The BUENO Center for Multicultural Education at CU Boulder is currently recruiting for an all Virtually offered Masters & CLD Endorsement cohort to begin spring semester January 2026.

This is an opportunity for teachers throughout the state of Colorado to simultaneously earn a Masters of Arts in Equity, Bilingualism & Biliteracy (EBB) with an Endorsement in Culturally & Linguistically Diverse Education (K-12) at the reduced tuition of \$1,500 per class x 10 classes = \$15,000 that is half the cost of our on-campus program. *Pay as you go

This cohort will be limited to participation by licensed Colorado K-12 teachers. Teachers will be selected by a competitive application process. A minimum of 25 teachers are needed to run this cohort.

Cohort Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a currently **licensed** classroom teacher in a Colorado school district.
- The applicant must have completed an undergraduate degree with a 2.75 GPA or higher.
- Must be a Colorado resident.
- Must have access to reliable Internet & have a laptop/computer.

All interested teachers must attend one of our virtual information sessions to obtain the BUENO application link.

*The BUENO application deadline is July 1st, 2025. Selected Cohort participants will be notified by mid-July with instructions on then how to apply the University of Colorado Graduate School *Grad application due by September 1st, 2025
