iceberg (noun) – a large floating piece of ice detached from a glacier that



floats on the sea.

elegant (adjective) – fancy and classy



wealthy (adjective) – having a lot of money or resources.

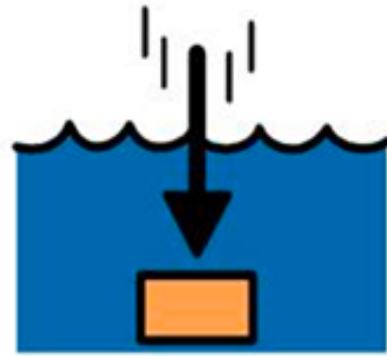
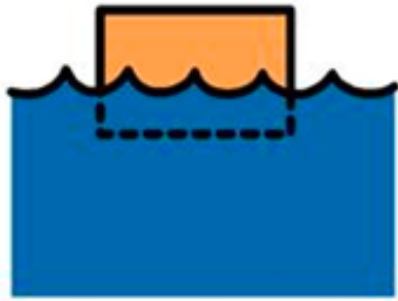
Alicia Keyes is a **wealthy** singer.

Qatar is a **wealthy** country because it has a lot of oil.

unsinkable (adjective) –

An object that will never sink. The prefix **un-** means “not.” The word sink means to go to the bottom of a liquid.

The Titanic was considered an **unsinkable** ship.

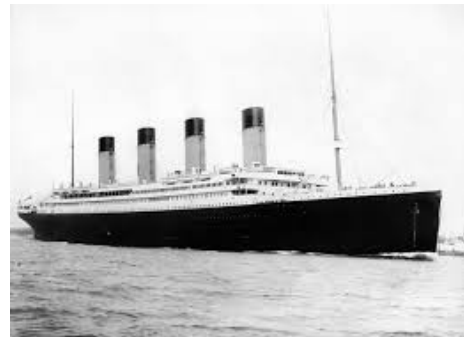


“spitting image” – A idiom or a phrase that means that a person looks exactly like another person. It can also mean that an object looks exactly like another object. The idiom spitting image means “an exact copy.”

For example:
John is the **spitting
image** of his father.
This means that John
looks just like his father.



The Titanic II is the **spitting image** of the RMS Titanic.



voyage – (noun) A long trip to a distant place that usually involves traveling over water or space.



The prefix **re-**

reproduction - (noun)

To make a copy of something. The prefix **re-** means “again.” The word production means to make. Therefore **reproduction** means to make again or to make a copy. In other words, it means to create a **replica** or **re-create**.

The Titanic II is a **reproduction** of the RMS Titanic.
