- A person who tricks another person.

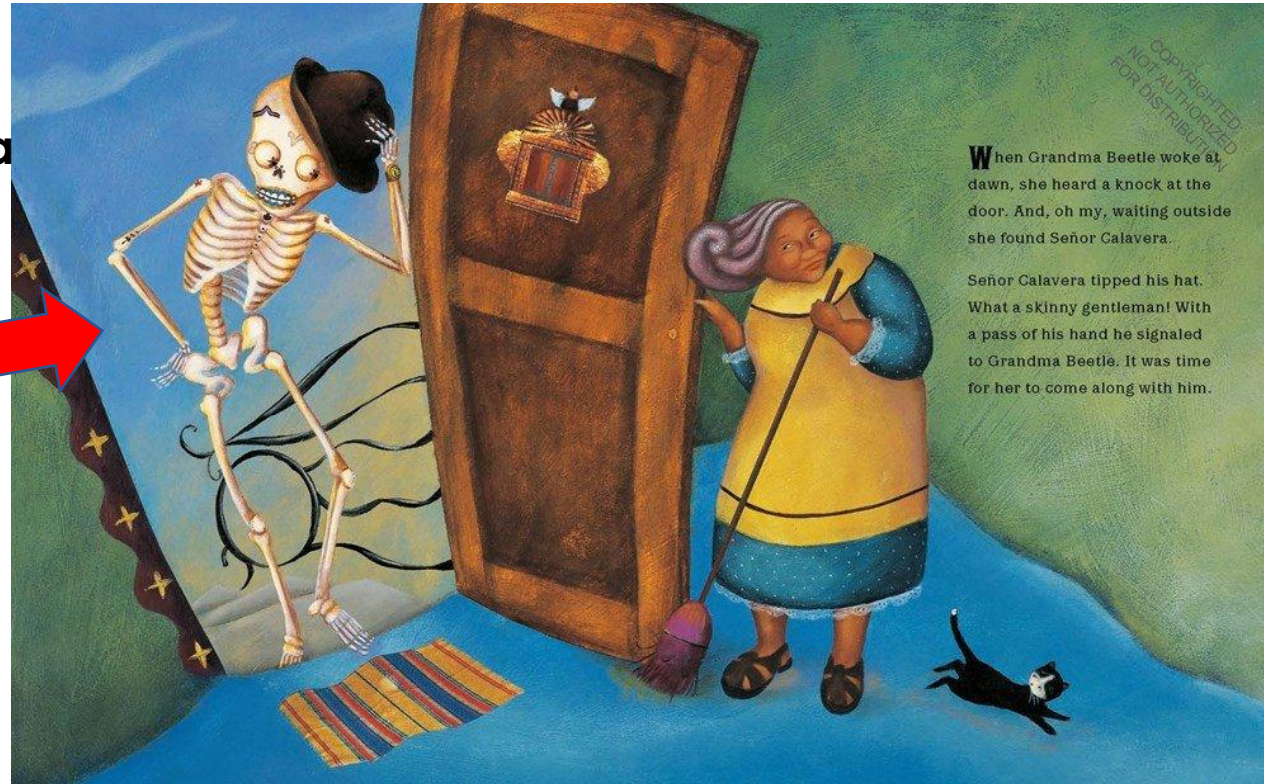
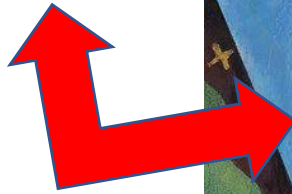
This story is about a trickster. Who do you think the trickster is?
