Application and Award Process

- Complete the CU Grad Student ESL Credit Program scholarship application.
- Write a short essay of no more than 250 words in which you discuss why you need to take the ESL Credit Program course, and how this course will assist you with your graduate studies and professional career.
- Submit the scholarship application and short essay via email to: ruth.moore@colorado.edu by the posted deadline.
- Completed applications, including essays, will be reviewed by a scholarship committee after the posted deadline.
- Awardees will be notified via the email given on the application.
- Scholarship awards are paid directly to your student bill. You must be enrolled in an ESL Credit Program course to receive a scholarship.
- Withdrawal from the course for which you are awarded the scholarship will result in the cancellation of the scholarship award. Dropping the course after the official drop deadline will make you ineligible for future ESL Credit Program Scholarship awards.
