HOW WE SERVE: Organizations Highlights



We work with Colorado schools to establish club chapters.

Teachers reach out to us to partner and enrich the limited STEM experiences provided for girls within their schools.

We organize and provide hands-on activities and field trips.

At each chapter, STEMblazers invites guest speakers and facilitates interactive discussions with STEM focused professionals covering the entire STEM spectrum. Hands on activities are paired with each guest speaker to make a career connection.

We work with girls on their essential skills and provide leadership opportunities.

Through our activities, girls learn about the importance of interpersonal skills such as body language, confidence, communication, peer leadership, teamwork and problem solving.

At the high school level we provide job shadowing & mentorship opportunities, networking and public speaking experiences.

Young women can choose to engage in a deeper dive experience through a job shadow with a STEM professional. We also provide student connections to mentors and encourage participation as public speakers.

Alumni receive additional opportunities to find internships and build their resume as they rise into their careers.
