Chemical and Biological Engineering Senior Thesis Application

Senior Thesis can be taken in place of Senior Lab or in conjunction with Senior Lab depending on GPA. Below are the two options:

- 1 Students with a Major GPA <a>>3.7 can take Senior Thesis in place of Senior Lab (BIEN 4810 or CHEN 4130). These students are also able to take Senior Lab if they like.
- 2 Students with a Major GPA < 3.7 with an accepted letter of recommendation from their research advisor can take Senior Thesis in conjunction with Senior Lab (BIEN 4810 or CHEN 4130). In this instance, Senior Thesis credits will count as engineering tech elective credits.

Senior Thesis has a class cap of 20 and priority is given to students with a GPA \geq 3.7, after which the course is filled on a first come, first served basis. To apply students must be seniors and have completed all junior-level BIEN/CHEN courses.

All forms must be typed. Email a completed and signed PDF of your application and your advisor's letter of recommendation to Dr. Renshaw at <u>deb.renshaw@colorado.edu</u> and Sr Thesis will be added to your schedule.
