### **SOME THINGS TO CONSIDER WHEN HIRING A TUTOR:**

A tutor's main function is to help the student understand concepts and apply this understanding to chemical problems; problem-solving logic and methodology will be emphasized. Because you've chosen to hire a private tutor, you should prepare to make the most efficient use of his/her

time. You should already have familiarity with the course material, even though you may not have full understanding. You should work, or at least attempt, the assigned problems before a tutorial session. You should formulate a list of questions to ask your tutor, questions about problems on which you've worked, but with which you have difficulty. If you are prepared, the tutor can probably help you overcome your difficulty quickly and easily. If not, you will waste both your money and your time.

A tutor does not know what will be on an exam. He/she will not guarantee a passing grade nor take responsibility for your performance in a course. Finally, you should realize that tutors are most often students themselves and may have priorities in their own work which limit their time and availability.
