#### 2. Application Essay 1

[double spaced, 3 pages or less, PDF, labeled ####ESSAY1]

- Describe your emerging filmmaking voice and vision using your moving image works as examples.
- Describe subjects, themes, methodologies (non-fiction, abstraction, animation, narrative, or others), and materials you are interested in exploring in your cinematic work.
- Cite specific examples of moving image work you have viewed in a CINE class that has influenced your artistic development, referencing the form and content of that work and the work you are submitting or aim to make while in the BFA.

## 3. Application Essay 2

[double spaced, 3 pages or less, PDF, labeled ####ESSAY2]

- How might the BFA act as a catalyst for your artistic, creative, intellectual, communal, and social growth and filmmaking practice?
- The BFA is a community-oriented and collaborative environment. What qualities, perspectives, and strengths would you contribute to the BFA cohort? What impact do you want your films to have?

#### 4. Moving Image Sample 1

[digital format, labeled ####BFAFILM1]

A two to four minute work of any film or video shot/created by you. Films with synch and non-synch sound are allowed.

## 5. Moving Image Sample 2

[digital format, labeled ####BFAFILM2]

A two to four minute work of any film or video shot/created by you. Films with sound are allowed.
