Awardees will be required to:

- Continue full-time enrollment for the 2024-25 academic year
- Check-in 2x/semesterly with the Program Managers in the Center for Inclusion and Social Change

 - Guillermo and Stephanie will reach out and introduce themselves—they provide advocacy and support for our ASSET/DACA/Undocumented students on campus!
 - Attend at least one Inspired Dreamers event per semester
