Admitted graduate students receive either a Teaching Assistantship or a Research Assistantship position that pays tuition remission, a monthly stipend of about \$2383 per month during the academic year and \$1,815 per semester towards the cost of the Gold Health Insurance plan. Students are required to pay student fees and the remaining portion of their health insurance costs.
